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STATEMENT OF CLAIM ISSUED PURSUANT TO LEAVE GRANTED ON THE 09/08/2019

- 1. The Plaintiff is a Limited Liability Company incorporated under the Laws of the Republic of Ghana and carries on business as a Bank in Ghana.
- 2. The Defendant is a customer of the Plaintiff Bank and a beneficiary of a short term loan facility.
- 3. The Defendant provided a personal guarantee for the grant of the facility and the due repayment of the loan the subject matter of this suit.
- 4. The Plaintiff avers that on or about the 16th December 2013, at the request of the Defendant it approved and granted a Short-Term Loan facility of Fifty Thousand Ghana Cedis (GH¢50,000.00) to augment his working capital.
- 5. The Plaintiff avers further that, the Defendant agreed that the facility was to be repaid in instalment over a period of twelve (12) months from the date of disbursement.
- 6. The Plaintiff avers that the facility was secured with;
 - (a) A Nissan Navara (243) vehicle with registration no. GN 2449-13, and
 - (b) A mortgage over a residential property situate as at Kasoa Odupongkhene residential area, Plot No. 134 belonging to the Defendant.
- 7. The Plaintiff states that, it was agreed that the Short-Term Loan would have an applicable interest rate of 30% per annum (25%p.a + margin of 5%) or such rate(s) as may be determined in the discretion of the bank from time to time.
- 8. The Plaintiff avers that, it was a term of the short term loan facility agreement that, any unfunded loan instalment and any amount outstanding on the Defendant's account at the expiry of the facility would attract a default charge of 2% flat.
- 9. The Plaintiff avers that contrary to the terms under which the loan was approved, the Defendant has refused to service or repay the facility in the manner agreed on, hence the Plaintiff decided to call in the facility before its expiration.
- 10. The Plaintiff again avers that the outstanding debit balance on the Defendant's account as at February 7th 2018 is Three Hundred and Three Thousand, Seven Hundred and Twenty-Five Ghana Cedis, Three Ghana pesewas (**GH¢303,725.03**) and continues to attract interest.
- 11. The Plaintiff avers further that, repayment of the outstanding debt is long overdue but the Defendant has failed and/or refused to pay despite repeated

demands, and will persist in its default unless ordered to pay by this Honourable Court.
